About Ypsomed

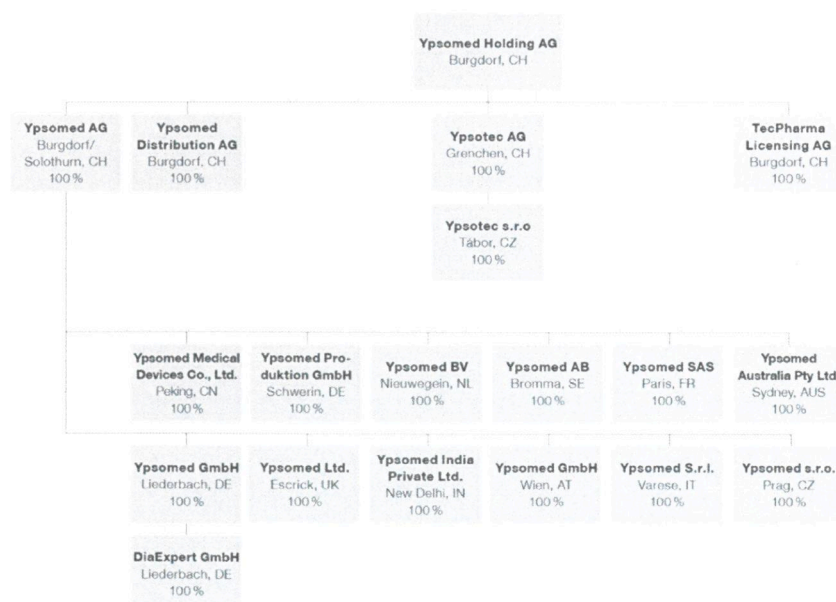
